## Short abstract:

Sensitization of the participants to the complex challenges of various stakeholders for the preservation of biodiversity on agricultural land in and directly next to nature reserves. There is neither an ideal farmer nor an ideal citizen or consumer. The existing discrepancies and the mutual lack of understanding between agricultural practice and the expectations of society should be made clear and lead to a future togetherness. Farmers will be challenged increasingly to adapt to the demands of society. However, they are an important group of actors who expect social support for taking on social tasks. Challenges such as food security, climate protection and biodiversity conservation must be mastered.

The aim of this workshop is to identify the corresponding heterogeneous challenges, interests and expectations as well as possible solutions involving all stakeholder groups.
