Final Oral Exam: Bachelor Thesis Colloquium

The following information is provided by the Examination Committee regarding the colloquium:

The bachelor thesis colloquium will focus on the topic covered in the bachelor thesis. The candidate is required to prove that he/she is able to present a topic that has been elaborated in detail and to explain subject-related contexts in relation to each other.

The topics of the Colloquium will depend on which examiners are nominated as members of the Examination Committees, with all members examining only in their specialist areas.

It is therefore recommended that candidates contact the respective examiners.

The **duration of the colloquium** should not be less than the allocated **30 minutes**.

The **presentation of the bachelor thesis** is part of the colloquium and has to be given within a time frame of **5-8 minutes**.

The presentation is to be included in the evaluation.

Provisions on Public Attendance are as set out in Article 4.1.4. of the General Provisions of Assessment Regulations (ABPO) of the Hochschule RheinMain (December 10, 2002), as well as in Article 3.4.7 of the ABPO of Hochschule Geisenheim University (December 9, 2014):

"Bachelor and Master colloquiums are generally open to university members, but this does not apply to the evaluation and announcement of the exam results".
