Registration Procedure and Regulation to Address the Effects of the SARS-CoV-2 Pandemic in Higher Education

The usual procedure to register in QIS remains unchanged. Students who failed an exam in the previous examination period will also be re-registered automatically.

Important Information:

- According to Corona Regulation § 3 Examinations (1), any examinations taken and not passed in the winter semester 2020/21 or the summer semester 2021 **which cannot be repeated** (failure at third attempt) are considered not taken, unless the exam was failed due to cheating or other serious violations of examinations regulations or several examinations of a module were ultimately not passed.
- If you have ultimately not passed an exam in the previous examination period (winter semester 2020/21), you will be re-admitted and re-registered for the next regular examination period (resit exam date 1 summer semester 2021)
- This means that you have one additional attempt to pass your exam
- According to the Corona Regulation, you have a so-called “free examination attempt” if you are taking your third examination attempt in the current examination period (summer semester date 1). If you fail the free examination attempt, you will be granted an additional third attempt.
- These conditions also apply for the summer semester 2021, date 2
