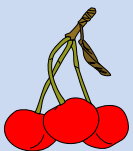


Gerema[®]

‘Kelleriis 14’ x ‘Heimanns Rubinweichsel’



- dwarfing variety, compatible with all rootstocks
- flowering late, blossom non-sensitive to rain and frost, self-fertile
- lateral flower formation on long spurs, addiction to form multiple buds, low brunch denudation
- early and high yield



- firm and dark fruit, non-susceptible to rain-induced cracking, dry stem scar
- special suitability for mechanical and stemless harvest
- very good suitability for canning, freezing and for juice



- less susceptible to monilia (brown rot) and stecklenberger disease
