Origin 1983



- vigorous, wide-pyramidal growth, late sprouting
- bears early, heavily and regularly, clustered in fructescence with an average of 3 fruits
- very late blossom, protandrous, fruit formation predominantly apomictic, fruitset 92 % , qualification as solitary tree



- late ripening, nuts are falling very clearly out of their shell
- big, egg-shaped, very regular and plain, small top - not much overhanging
- shell with medium thickness, firm, plain, less crenated, obvious rib, closed very good, although easy to open, colour ocher to light brown
- kernel fills in the shell, peels away completely out of the shell, with yellow colour and clearly, dark wires
- very good flavour, strong nuttily



- resistant to bacterial rot (*Xanthomonas campestris pv. juglandis*)
- insusceptible to anthracnose (*Marssonina juglandis*)
- tree is totaly vital and climatic robust
