

Terms of Use
of Publicly Accessible Computers at the Library of GEISENHEIM University

1. The Library of the Geisenheim University, hereafter referred to as Library, grants permission to any user holding a valid library card to use publicly accessible computers for research and any other purposes related to the Geisenheim University (intended use). (Any other than the intended use needs prior approval by authorized personal.) Private and/ or business use is strictly prohibited.
2. Publicly accessible computers are for intended use only.
3. It is not allowed to install, persistently copy onto or erase any data from the computer's hard drive. Neither is it allowed to change or modify any system settings of the computer and the running operating system, especially the control panel.
4. The user is obligated to check the condition of the computer. In case of hardware defects or error notices the Library's personal has to be notified instantly. The computer desk has to be left clean and tidy.
5. Computers are accessible during opening hours. Printers have to be properly loaded with blank white paper, 80g per m². If you encounter any trouble feel free to ask our personnel.
6. Liability for any damage to the equipment, media or items of the Library lies entirely with the person causing the damage. Those liable will be charged to the full extend.
7. The Library's Websites have links to other state and federal agencies. We also link to other organization's Websites when there is a business reason to do so. This linking does not constitute the Library's endorsement of the content of their Web sites or of their policies or products.
8. Any instructions issued by Library staff must be followed.
9. The usage of electronic devices not provided by the Library needs prior approval.
10. In any case of breaching these terms and conditions the Library is entitled to exclude the respective user temporarily or entirely from using library services.
