

ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

FOR THE ELECTIONS TO THE SENATE IN

WS 2019/20

The elections for the members group of Students of the HGU Senate will be held January 21 to 23, 2020.

General information

The Senate of the Hochschule Geisenheim University (HGU) consists of 17 members:

- nine professors,
- three students,
- three academic and scientific staff members
- two administrative and technical staff members.

The term of office begins on March 1, 2020. The term of office of the representatives of the students is one year.

Who can vote and who can be elected?

Students and staff of the HGU have the right to vote (see electoral elections of HGU). All those eligible to vote are also eligible to stand as candidates in the election. A person's right to vote will be verified through an electoral roll compiled by the University.

Electoral roll

You may check your registration in the electoral roll

December 11 to 13, 2019, 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Admissions Office (Müller-Thurgau-Haus).

Standing as a candidate

A person can stand in the elections by submitting a correctly filled out and signed declaration of candidature confirmed by the Election Office (Wahlbüro) by Wednesday, December 4, 2019, 12.00 p.m. Electoral proposal forms are available on HGU's website: https://www.hs-geisenheim.de/wahl/wahlen-zum-senat/ from Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Voting time

During the election days, voting is possible in the Campus Building during the following periods

Tuesday, January 21, 2020, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Wednesday, January 22, 2020, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Thursday, January 23, 2020, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Those entitled to vote must prove their identity with an official ID.

Absentee voting

There is the possibility of postal voting. An application for receiving postal voting documents must be submitted to the election office by Tuesday, January 7, 2020, 12:00 p.m. You will then receive your postal voting documents and further information by post.



Publication of the election result

An unofficial election result is planned to be published on January 24, 2020. The official result will be published on February, 4, 2020.

For students, the elections to the student parliament are organized together with the elections to the Senate.
