

## **Important Information on Insurance Coverage Abroad**

Participation in an exchange program or the award of a scholarship does not include any form of insurance coverage. You should therefore arrange for adequate insurance coverage well in advance.

Please find out which form of **health insurance** you will need in your country of destination and seek advice from your statutory health insurance provider (*Krankenkasse*). For stays in one of the EU member states, students insured with the German statutory healthcare system can obtain a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) from their *Krankenkasse*. Different arrangements apply for students with private health insurance. Please ask your health insurance company for details. Please also find out which additional insurance cover you will require.

Students are strongly advised to take out their own **liability and accident insurance**. Hochschule Geisenheim University and the State of Hesse are not liable for any damages incurred. However, liability is possible within the framework of the liability and accident insurance taken out by the Studentenwerk Frankfurt.
