You are almost there! Now that you have arrived in Germany, it's time to make your way to Geisenheim. Below will be a guide on how to arrive to Geisenheim from the Frankfurt International Airport.

There will also be some tips incase you arrive at another major airport in Germany - which can sometimes be the case.





- Frankfurt International has two terminals
- The Frankfurt regional train station called the
 Frankfurt Flughafen Regionalbahnhof is in Terminal 1
- It is here where you will find the trains going in the direction of Geisenheim/Wiesbaden/Mainz

You have to buy your ticket BEFORE boarding the train!

Do not enter a train without a ticket - the fine for riding a train or a bus without a ticket is 60 euros.

There are machines from which you can buy tickets at the train stations.




The apps

The RMVgo and the DB apps are the best ones to use when planning your trips. In case you are not able to buy physical tickets, you can buy them on the app. For this, it's best if you have a paypal account or credit card.

Google Maps

Google Maps can also be useful when planning the trip. But keep in mind that at times it may not be the most accurate.





TRIP TIPS

1

The easiest way is to take the S9 train from Frankfurt (Main) Flughafen Regionalbahnhof direction Wiesbaden

2

Exit at Wiesbaden Hbf (Hauptbahnhof/main train station)

3

Take the RB10 direction Neuwied (alternatively it could say Kaub, Koblenz or Assmanshausen). This train usually leaves from platform 1.


This train goes directly to Geisenheim.

NOT COMING FROM FRANKFURT IINTERNATIONAL AIRPORT?

There is the chance that you arrive to one of the other airports in Germany that are near Geisenheim. In that case, usually the Cologne/Bonn airport is one of those.

There has even been the instance for Dortmund as well.

Again you buy tickets at the train stations - but given that these are a bit further away, it is best to buy your ticket in advance with the DB app. Detailed information on your trip is available on the app.



HOW TO GET TO GEISENHEIM FROM FRANKFURT HAHN

There is a chance that you arrive in Frankfurt Hahn Airport. Despite the name, this is not the same airport as Frankfurt International and is also not close to it.

To get to Geisenheim, you first need to take a bus to Mainz. The bus company is called "Flibco", you can find their website here: www.flibco.com.

In Mainz, the bus stops next to the train station. Take a train to Wiesbaden (S6 or S8) and there change trains again to go to Geisenheim with the RB 10 (see above).

Again, buy your tickets before you get onto the train. The bus ticket can be purchased directly at the airport or online.
