- Second reading of the motion to amend the financial regulations (Lena Berghaus):
The financial regulations are to be amended so that AstA working students can be paid beyond the tax-exempt amount within a single month while maintaining the same hourly wage (minimum wage). This is intended to ensure that overtime can be compensated promptly and does not, for example, have to be paid out during the semester break.
- Motion to purchase freezers (Louisa von der Mark):
The AstA would like to purchase two new freezer chests for events, as the old models are no longer food-safe. Three offers were obtained, and offer 1 was selected. Although this is the most expensive option, it can be delivered the fastest.
