



After a successful first edition last year, the project team of the "Gründungsfabrik Rheingau", together with experts from research and industry, invites you to the "Drink Innovation Challenge" (DIC) for the second time. Under the motto "Your Drink comes true", innovative and delicious ideas for non-alcoholic beverages are being sought, which at the same time should take up aspects of sustainability. You are cordially invited to participate as an individual or team!

As the motto suggests, your idea should not only be thought through, but in the best case be realised and bottled at the Beverage Technology Centre of Geisenheim University (HGU). In addition, attractive prize money, exciting industry contacts and more await you. The competition will be accompanied by exciting

lectures on the core topics of the competition innovation and sustainability. In this context, Vanessa Mark from the sustainability office of the HGU and Dr. Jan Christoph Munck-Rieder (EBS) will work out with interested parties in a creative innovation workshop on 18 April 2023 under the title "New & Sustainable - Idea Meets Responsibility" how innovation is created and in which direction the competition will develop.

Prof. Dr. Moritz Wagner (Institute for Applied Ecology at HGU) will provide participants and interested parties with helpful information on assessing sustainability and avoiding risks such as green-washing in the sustainability workshop "Sustainable Beverages - how to go green" on 4 May. The DIC application window is now open at www.gruendungsfabrik-rheingau.de. The deadline for submission is 21 May 2023. After pre-selection by the expert jury, the best idea will be determined and selected during a final pitch event at the career fair "meet@hochschule-geisenheim" on 21 June 2023 at Geisenheim University of Applied Sciences.

WHAT IS THE ZUKUNFTSSYMPOSIUM?

The Symposium in the Future Year 2023 is a project by students for students at Geisenheim University. The goals of the symposium are to create a future-oriented and practice-oriented interaction between students, companies, personalities and the university itself. The event is aimed at students from Bachelor and Master programmes, as well as speakers and companies.

The focus is on wine business, viticulture, logistics and beverage technology. A promising network will be established through workshops, case studies and networking events. Students have the opportunity to apply with their CVs, which will then be forwarded to the participating companies. The companies can invite selected students to exclusive programme points.

The Zukunftssymposium will take place on 02 and 03 June 2023. The opening ceremony and the afternoon event on 02 June are free to attend, all other programme items are exclusive. Participation is only possible after successful registration. More information can be found at the bottom of the page under Registration.



The following things are required for participation in exclusive programme items of the Zukunftssymposium 2023:

- 1. You must have registered for the event Zukunftssymposium 2023, via the job portal. Please note that a good CV is a basic requirement for participation. If you are not yet registered on the Job Portal, you must do so in advance
- 2. After you have registered, you will receive a confirmation e-mail that your application has been received.
- 3. After the closing date on **07 May 2023***, your CVs will be reviewed and checked for quality. Following this, you will receive an email regarding your application status. If more than 50 students apply successfully, the lottery will decide.
- 4. If you have been admitted to the Zukunfts-symposium, you will receive information on the payment of the flat-rate fee of €25.00 in your application status e-mail. This flat-rate contribution will enable us to provide you with food and drinks during the 2 days. Please note that the flat-rate contribution of 25,00€ is excluded from refunds.
- 5. Note: If you are not an alumni, please register <u>here</u> in advance.


