
Mentor Program



Rules of Conduct during Exams

The repeat exams of the winter semester will take place soon, starting from May 25th. In order to maximize the safety of everyone involved, the following rules of conduct have been established:

□ All students have been assigned to specific lecture halls, choosing one will not be possible

	The seating plans (ensuring a distance of 1,5 m minimum) are to be complied with		
	The marked seats are to be taken without exception.		
	While entering or exiting the lecture halls, the current rules of distance are to be followed		
	The hygiene rules of the RKI are to be followed		
	A face mask has to be worn before the exam, while taking a seat, while		
	submitting the exam and until after exiting the lecture hall		
	During the exam, the face mask may be taken off		
	Going to the toilet is to be reduced if possible. The safety concepts are to be		
	respected in the bathrooms (see the <u>hygiene plan</u>).		
Further notes of the examinations office:			
	Students among a risk group may "cancel" with a doctor's note		
	Students in a cohabitation with people belonging to a risk group are permitted to cancel by informing the examinations office		
	The valid deadlines are to be kept		
All additional questions will be answered by the staff of the <u>examinations office</u> .			
Please note that the <u>hygiene plan</u> will be intact on campus until the end of the semester.
