Did you know? Erasmus+ Update!

Starting next year, there will be a great new feature in the Erasmus+ funding program for studying and internships abroad: in addition to the monthly allowances, there will now be a travel allowance on top! The amount of the allowance depends on the distance to the destination country and is higher if low-emission travel is used (e.g. train, bike or carpooling).

What does this mean for you? Here is an example:

For a four-month semester at the Norwegian University of Life Sciences in Norway, you will receive €600 per month. If you are eligible for the "Social Top Up" (see QR code for more information), you will receive an additional £250 per month, bringing your total to £850 monthly. Additionally, you will receive a £309 one-time allowance for your travel expenses. Are you traveling by train? Great! Then you will even receive a travel allowance of £417.

EVALUATION

Dear students,

During your studies, you will be regularly invited to participate in surveys evaluating university life and the courses you attend.

The first-semester and satisfaction surveys (see below) will begin on November 14, 2025.

But what exactly does , evaluation' mean in this context?



Evaluation refers to the analysis and interpretation of data that measure the impact of processes, institutions, and individuals. In most cases, this data is collected through various surveys. These surveys are essential for ensuring the quality of teaching and learning at the university.

At the end of each semester, you will be asked to participate in course **evaluations** by completing an online survey about the seminars and lectures you have attended. The results of these surveys are crucial for teachers to further develop their courses.

You will also be asked to participate in three major surveys during your studies:

- 1. **First semester survey:** This survey aims to capture your impressions of your first weeks at university. We would like to learn about your experience starting out, and whether there are ways to improve the beginning of your studies.
- 2. **Satisfaction survey:** This takes place in your third or fifth semester and gauges your satisfaction with your studies so far. It also asks about possible areas for improvement and the general conditions at the university.
- 3. **Graduate survey:** This survey provides an opportunity to reflect on your studies and your preparation for your career after graduation.

Your input is vital to helping the university continue to develop its courses and teaching. Every voice counts, especially since we're such a small institution.




