AStA STUDY ROOM RENOVATED AND NOW AVAILABLE AGAIN

The AStA study room at Brentanostraße 9 was renovated as part of a collaboration between the Infrastructure, University Didactics & E-Learning departments and the AStA.

The flooring was replaced, the walls were painted, and new furniture was even purchased: there are two seating areas with four chairs each, two seating areas with eight chairs each, a standing table, and a seating area with a sofa, armchair, and bench. The seating areas can be screened off with partitions, which also offer the option of labeling on one side. All furniture is on casters and can therefore be moved and rearranged as needed. One wall area is completely covered with writable "whiteboard wallpaper," as already known from the CoLab.

A total of just under €15,000 was spent on the renovation work and new purchases.

We are very proud of this and would like to express our sincere thanks to everyone involved, especially Carolin Richardt, Jutta Gieselmann, Ramon Hahn, and Mirjam Hey.

REVIEW OF DRY JANUARY TASTING

Dry January at university - alcohol-free, but surprisingly exciting


For many people, non-alcoholic beverages are not something they have high expectations of. But that's exactly what made the Dry January tasting at the university so interesting. Because it wasn't about abstinence, but about the question of what's actually behind the hype surrounding non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.

After a brief introduction to what "non-alcoholic" really means and why it doesn't automatically mean "0.0%," it quickly became clear that the market is bigger, more diverse, and more exciting than expected.

Non-alcoholic wines, sparkling teas, fruit-based aperitif alternatives, and non-alcoholic signature drinks were tasted. The same question kept coming up: Does this really taste like something? The answer usually came straight from the glass and caused some surprised faces and honest moments of realization.

Between tastings, there were insights into manufacturing processes, consumption trends, and the reasons why non-alcoholic beverages are gaining more and more attention, especially among younger target groups. Incidentally, it became clear that many of these products are not intended to be substitutes, but rather represent a drinking moment in their own right.

In the end, curiosity remained above all else. Curiosity about new products, new concepts, and perhaps also about simply trying something different in your glass at the next occasion. Still curious about the non-alcoholic drinks from Dry January? Then simply ask for the leftover products at Fass and try them for yourself to see if anything surprises you.




