

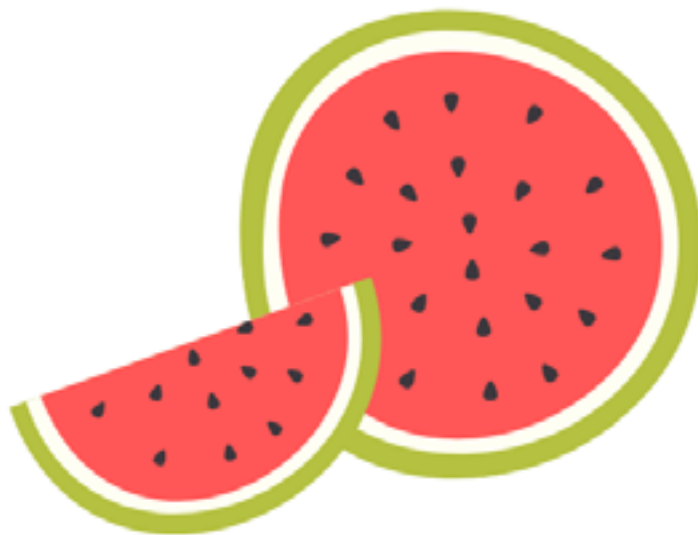
Including: the **study days and nights at YouCa**, practical **study tips for more relaxed learning** and little motivational boosters for in between.

What can students study at your university?

Students can choose from programs in science, trades, business, health, and culinary arts. Many of these programs include applied learning through real-world assignments in labs, workshops, and clinics.

What is special about your university?

OC offers many opportunities for student engagement through recreational, cultural, and entrepreneurial activities. What we like is that building a personal relationship with professors is easy because the learning environment is practical, with small classroom sizes that provide a personalized learning experience.

Why should students come to your university?

Students will enjoy a vibrant student life. The campus is close to outdoor attractions like Okanagan Lake for swimming and Big White (hiking and biking in the summer and skiing in the winter). There are also opportunities to get involved in clubs, sports, and community projects. There are a variety of clubs run by students that host events like trivia and professional panels where you can network and enjoy with other students! The College is also near many wineries which are cool to tour.

What is the best time to visit Canada?

From May to September for warm weather activities, and from December to March if you enjoy snow sports like skiing or snowboarding. The campus is very close to Lake Okanagan, where you can enjoy swimming and activities like beach volleyball or spikeball if you like the heat!

ORIENTATION - PROMOTION - CAREER

Do you have travel tips for Canada?

Bring clothes for different seasons and explore locally. Public transportation in Canada is not as easily accessible as in Europe, but renting a car can help you explore more remote areas. Vancouver, Alberta's Rockies and the Kootenay region are fairly close and are a must see while in Canada if you have the chance! Kelowna is a very beautiful place and if you have the opportunity to travel there we would highly recommend it.

Which dish should you try in Canada?

You should try poutine, a classic Canadian dish with fries, cheese curds, and gravy. Also explore local specialties from the various diverse cuisines from the variety of cultures in Canada and the Indigenous-inspired cuisine. There is a large variety of restaurants in Kelowna and it is always fun to go out and try something new!

Green Office: Survey shows positive impact on Campus

Thank you to all the students and staff who participated in our Green Office survey!

Practical initiatives — such as the bike repair stations, menstrual product dispensers, and the swap shelf—received especially positive feedback. Less well-known but still valuable are projects with a more theoretical focus or a limited local impact, such as surveys or smaller technical measures. Many participants expressed a desire for more hands-on activities and workshops. With the bike workshop on June 18th, we've already begun turning some of these ideas into action.

Most of you heard about the Green Office through emails or conversations on campus. For many, the first point of contact was the „Ersti-Rallye“ (orientation event for new students) — an important introduction. We're especially excited about all the ideas you shared for improving existing projects and launching new ones.

nRNA TRILOG for Research: Collaborating for a Sustainable Future

On June 5, 2025, around 50 researchers from Hochschule Geisenheim, TH Bingen, and EBS University came together for the first nRNA-TRILOG for Research, with the goal of jointly advancing sustainable research.

Under the motto “Sustainable Research – Synergies, Strategies, Solutions,” participants engaged in discussions, networking, and collaborative project development. In interactive sessions, they explored initial ideas for cooperation and exchanged insights on funding opportunities and shared strategies.

The key takeaway: The TRILOG demonstrated how vital real encounters and open exchange are for sustainable research. New ideas emerge when people with diverse perspectives come together and think forward—together.

RECAP GREEN OFFICE

CoLAB Officially Opened – A Space for New Ways of Learning

With a vibrant program of workshops, music, a flea market, and homemade ice cream and elderflower lemonade by our apprentice company, the new CoLAB in the lecture hall building was officially opened on June 11th.

In her welcome speech, Prof. Dr. Mirjam Hey introduced the concept: flexible learning spaces that support collaborative, competency-based work — across the entire campus, both indoors and outdoors. As part of the opening, the first new outdoor furniture pieces were also officially introduced. They were created as part of a holistic approach to designing learning environments and align with the principles of Education for Sustainable Development (ESD). These additions expand the range of open-air learning spaces and encourage informal, communal learning in green surroundings.

The CoLAB is part of a comprehensive spatial concept supported by the state of Hesse's QuiS program, combining learning, sustainability, and student well-being.

And there's more to come: Additional outdoor furniture will be installed over the summer — including table-bench combinations that allow you to work directly in the fresh air. Stay tuned!

Bike Repair Workshop at the "Altes Weinfass"

On June 18, interested participants had the opportunity to learn practical tips and tricks about bicycle maintenance at the bike repair workshop held at the Altes Weinfass. Student Lenny demonstrated, among other things, how to change a tire and adjust brakes — valuable knowledge that not only helps save money but also supports sustainable mobility.

Although the evening was a bit quieter than expected, we were still able to share some helpful insights—and we appreciate every single contribution to a more bike-friendly campus culture. We've taken away useful lessons for future workshops and are motivated to further develop the format.

“From idea to pitch” is the motto of the Gründungsfabrik Rheingau FOUNDER WORKSHOP, which starts on October 10 and consists of several modules designed to prepare founders for discussions with potential investors, partners and customers.



The road to starting your own business can be stony. In any case, a good idea and the right attitude are only the beginning, and there are various hurdles to overcome before you get your first customer. Anyone who wants to start a business should get as much support as possible beforehand and take advantage of offers that help them avoid potential mistakes and prepare for all kinds of professionally successful discussions.



Gründungsfabrik Rheingau is offering an opportunity to all founders from the region and the two universities – EBS University and Geisenheim University – this October. In three modules, each lasting three days, the most important aspects of starting a business will be explored in intensive workshops based on the participants’ own ideas. At the end, participants will be able to clearly formulate their mission and goals. They will have a precise idea of the magic behind their figures and how to use them to convince potential partners to invest, grant a loan, enter into a partnership, or collaborate. They will be ready for the “pitch.”

Using various agile, creative, and team-building methods, Alexandra Wagner-Thind – a business coach with over 25 years of experience in advising founders – not only imparts important know-how, but above all the joy of letting your own idea take flight.

The workshop will be held in English. You can now apply for one of the limited places. Participation costs EUR 450.00 for students for all 3 modules and a total of 9 days of workshops – snacks and drinks included (EUR 900.00 for alumni and founders from the Rheingau-Taunus district).

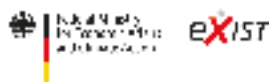
