## Meet our International Students

**University:** Faculty of Agricultural Sciences at the National University of Cuyo (UNCuyo) - Mendoza - Argentina

**Study Program:** Agricultural engineering

### What can students study at your home university?

The National University of Cuyo offers a wide range of academic programs divided among 12 faculties. In this case, the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences at the National University of Cuyo (UNCuyo) offers a wide range of academic programs, including technical degrees, bachelor degrees, and postgraduate degrees in areas related to agriculture, natural resources, and food.

Within this academic offering, it is interesting to highlight the following undergraduate programs:

1. Agricultural Engineering: Provides comprehensive training in plant and animal production, conservation, and transformation of agricultural products.
2. Renewable Natural Resources Engineering: Teaches sustainable management of soil, water, flora, and fauna.
3. Bachelor's Degree in Food Science: Specializes in food safety, analysis, and control.

The Faculty of Agricultural Sciences:



### What is special about your home university?

In addition to the high quality of teaching offered by the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, as well as the opportunity to study surrounded by trees in the faculty's parks or even within the botanical garden, or to visit or work on animal or plant production within the faculty grounds, I believe that what most characterizes the Faculty is the quality of the people who make up the university environment. From contact with the directors of related organizations to the directors of the faculty's degree programs, the professors of the different subjects, and the students themselves from different academic years, everyone is always willing to share, learn, and help.



A clear example of this is a meeting we organized with my classmates on the faculty grounds (with the permission of the directors). We invited the professors of each of the subjects we had taken that year, including the dean of the faculty and members of the board of directors, and we had a great afternoon sharing what is called an "Asado Argentino", which included food, music, chatting, and wine from the faculty.



# ORIENTATION - PROMOTION - CAREER

This gathering was not a one-off event, because it is often the professors themselves who encourage you to create these events and generate contact with different groups throughout your years of study.



## Do you have travel tips for the region you are from?

Mendoza, in the Cuyo region, is an area known throughout the country for its natural beauty and world-class wine production. For this reason, and depending on the time of year you visit Mendoza, my advice would be:

1. Explore nature: There are many opportunities for outdoor activities such as hiking, cycling, and rafting. In turn, a visit to the Villavicencio Nature Reserve, a walk through the Aconcagua Provincial Park, and other areas of the Andes Mountains are sure to be great experiences.
2. Plan a visit to wineries: This is a very popular activity in Mendoza, and not all of them are located near the city. For example, the Uco Valley, one of the most emblematic destinations in the province and where most of the world-renowned wines come from, is approximately 90km away. For this reason, I consider it very important that you take into account transportation and reservations for a guided tour or restaurant at the winery of your choice.
3. Consider local festivals: If you are in Mendoza between February and March, you should go to one of the most important events in the province: The National Harvest Festival. During this time, the city is filled with color and joy with parades, musical performances, and tastings. It is a great opportunity to immerse yourself in the local culture and enjoy a unique experience.
4. Don't just stick to Mendoza: If you have the opportunity, visit other provinces and other places in Argentina, as there is a great diversity of cultures and landscapes within the country, from deserts and jungles to glaciers and vast plains. Highlights include the Perito Moreno Glacier in the south of the country, the mountainous region of Jujuy in the northwest, and the Iguazú Falls in the northeast.

## Which dish should you try in your region?

If you travel to Argentina, the must-try foods are asado and empanadas. I would also like to mention dulce de leche, alfajores, and mate.

Something special about Argentine cuisine is that it is often best enjoyed in a homey/handmade setting, since we consider the simple act of sharing a mate with some biscuits, while we light the fire and prepare the empanadas that will be served as an appetizer before the different cuts of meat and salads that make up the asado, to be part of a "ritual".

If you happen to go on exchange to the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences at Uncuyo, I assure you that you will not return home without understanding what I am talking about.

## What surprised you most when you came to Germany?

To be honest, it wasn't the first time I had traveled far from Argentina, but it was my first time in Europe, so many of the things I saw made quite an impression on me. But if I had to choose some of the first things I thought and understood as part of what it means to be German, it would be the culture of German bread and sausage. The wide variety and high quality of these two types of products really invited me to try them, and I can say that they did not disappoint. Nowadays, every time I go to the bakery, I choose something different from all the previous times, just to try all the varieties on offer and decide which ones I like the most.

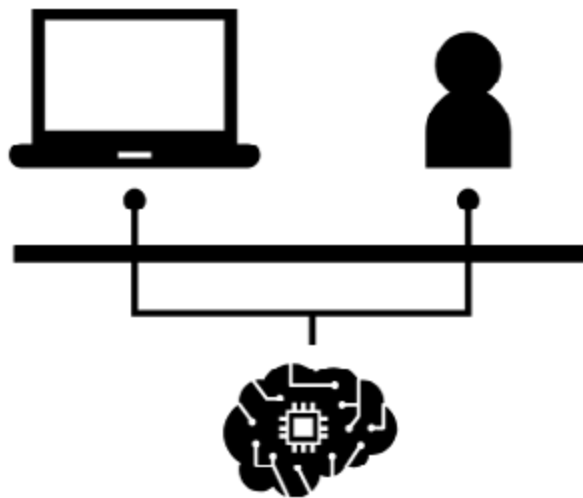
