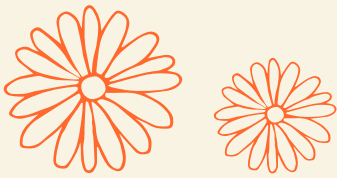


# Sustainability report

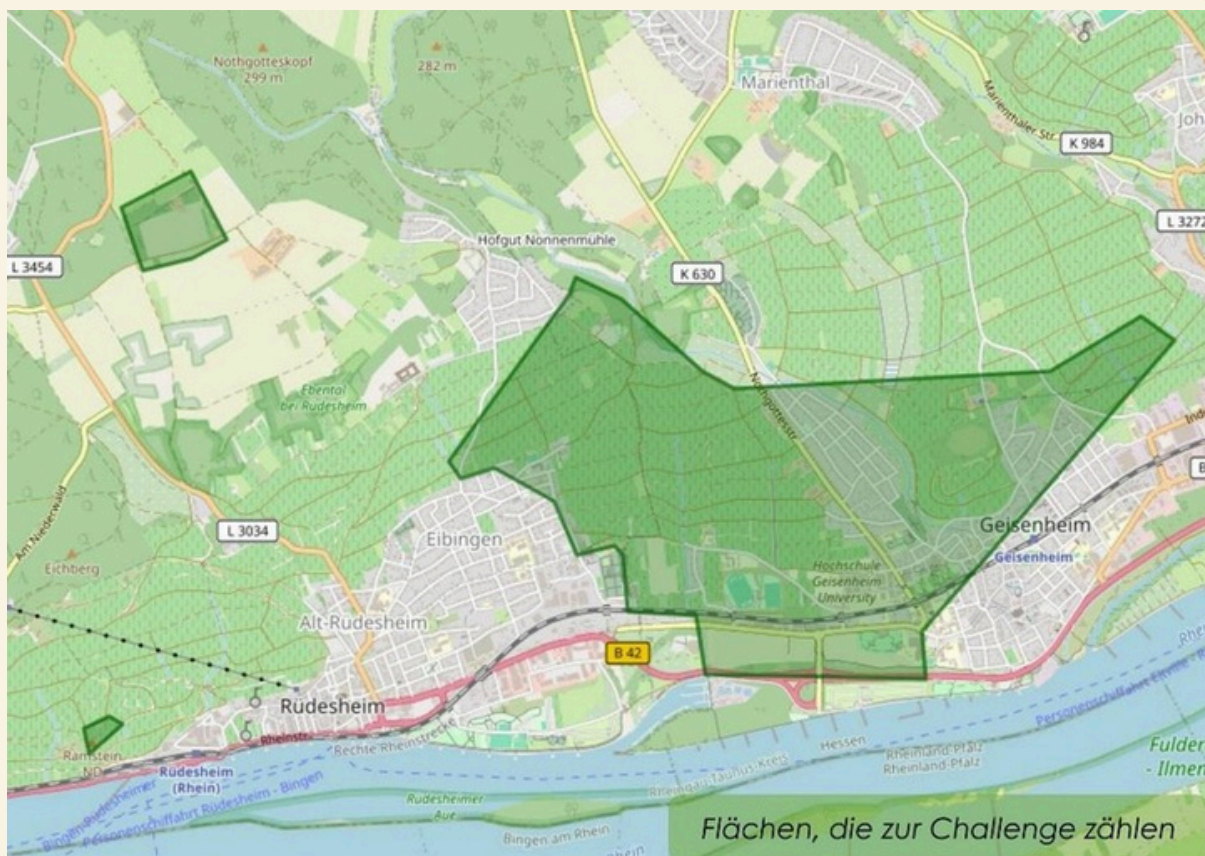


Nachhaltigkeit leben – Whole Institution Approach der Hochschule Geisenheim
