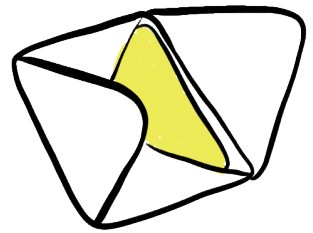
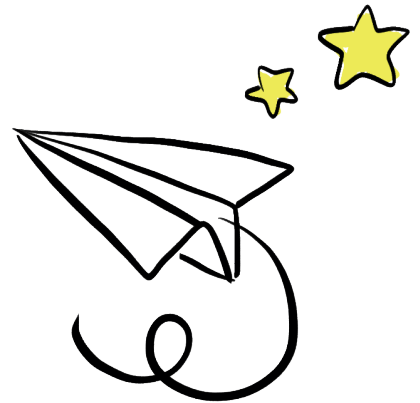
Without support from the office, we're screwed!

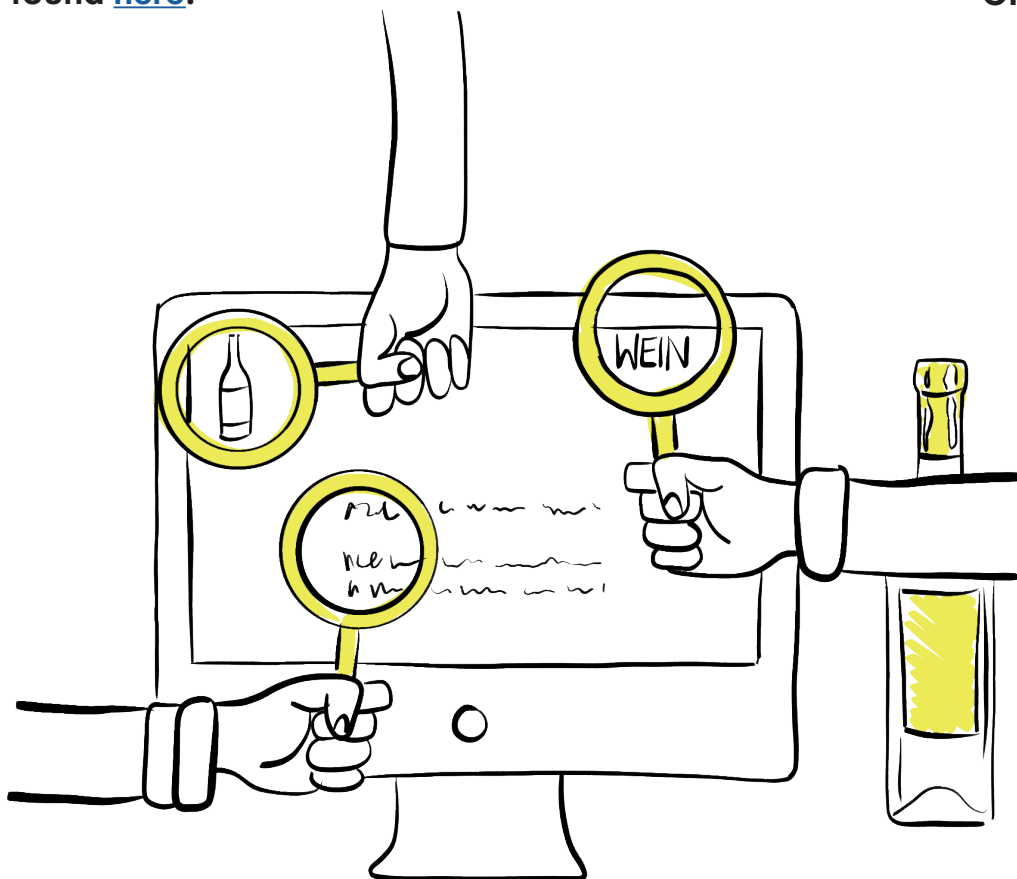

BOOK RECOMMENDATION

A good book is balm for the soul. The lecture-free period is approaching, and we can once again take more time to immerse ourselves in novels, crime novels, thrillers, comics or non-fiction books in addition to our compulsory reading. In our new section, we will be presenting books worth reading in the future. Do you have a book that would inspire us? We want to know! Mr. Seifert from the Fresenius University of Applied Sciences will start us off with an excursion into the universe...

RIDDLES OF COSMOLOGY

A slim little volume with only 115 pages of text explores one of the most exciting questions that has occupied science for more than 100 years:

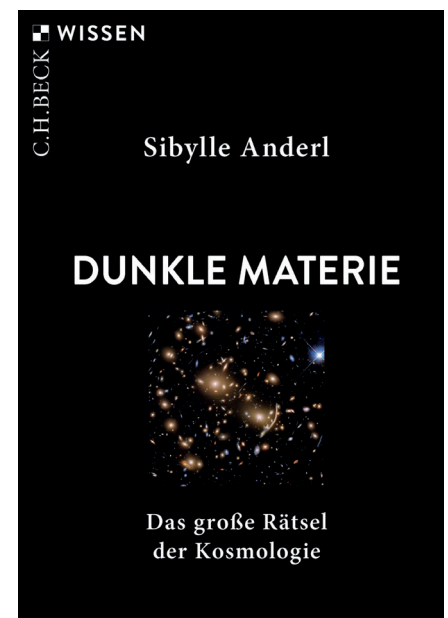
What is the 85% of matter in our universe - called „dark matter“ - made of, the nature of which we do not (yet) know? The author has a doctorate in astrophysics and is an editor in the science section of the Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung.

First she explains why there is speculation about „dark matter“ at all („The entire cosmos would look different if it did not exist“). Then possible candidates and ideas are presented. The third chapter explores questions about where the standard model of physics might show weaknesses. Finally, points of philosophy of science are discussed („If our scientific theories were completely wrong, then their success would be extremely astonishing“).

Is the book challenging? Most certainly! But why not: think about one of the really big questions for once! Gain in knowledge is guaranteed. In general, the books in the series „C.H.Beck Wissen“ are recommendable and very suitable for a basic stock of a private library.

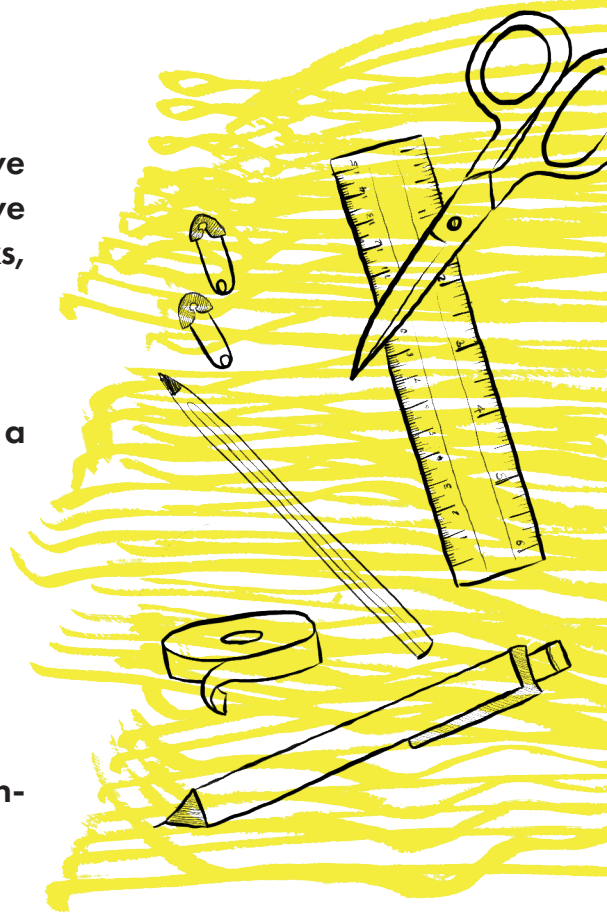

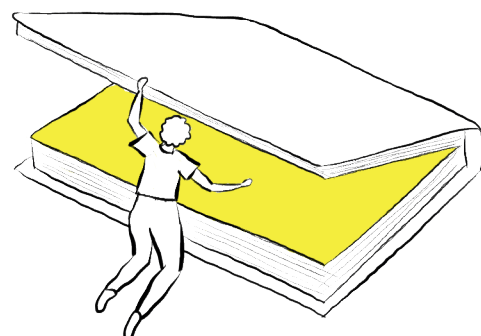

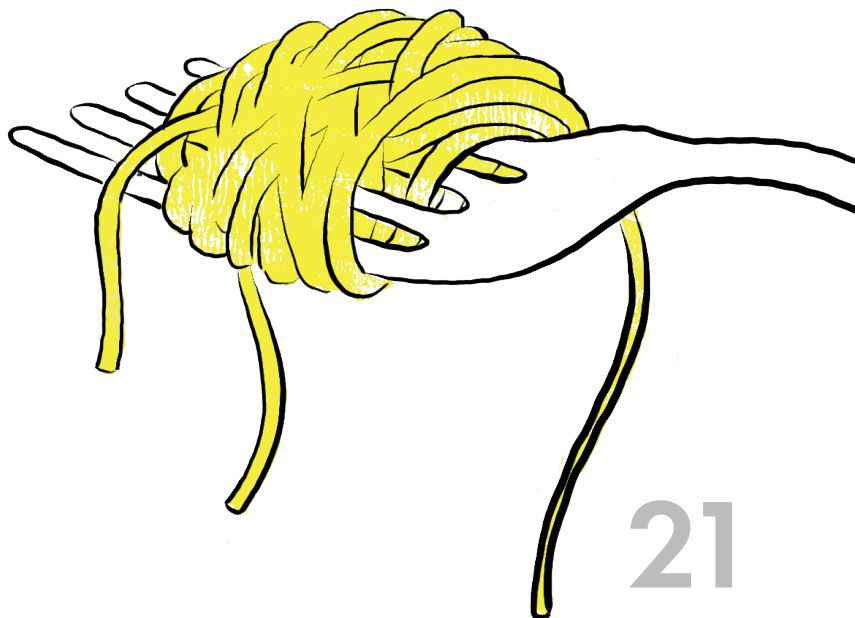
