

**Protocol of the 4th Ordinary Meeting of the General Student Committee of Geisenheim University in the Summer Semester 2025, Tuesday July 1, 2025, 7:00 p.m., AStA Learning Room**



**Agenda Item 1: Opening of the meeting**

The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m. by AStA Executive Committee member Tobias Görres.

**Agenda Item 2: Determination of the quorum**

A quorum is established.

**Agenda Item 3: Determination of the chair of the meeting and taking of minutes**

The meeting is led by Maximilian Unfried and Tobias Görres. Minutes will be taken by Louisa von der Mark.

**Agenda Item 4 Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting**

The minutes of the 3rd regular meeting in the summer semester 2025 are approved without objection.

**Agenda Item 5: Resolution on the agenda**

The agenda is adopted without changes.

**Agenda Item 6: Green Office: Outdoor furniture**

- There are plans to install another round of new outdoor furniture on campus.
- A bench in the roundabout and two picnic table combinations (probably under the lime tree in the bulge) are planned.  
→ The picnic tables are to be firmly anchored in the ground.
- The planned locations have been confirmed without change. Once the furniture has been delivered at the beginning of the semester, the final positioning will be reviewed.

**Agenda Item 7 Old Wine Barrel: Debriefing on the barrel anniversary, preview of barrel evenings**

- Overall positive feedback on the barrel anniversary, good organization and atmosphere.
- Approval for extended opening hours until midnight was given verbally, but not confirmed in writing – in future, written confirmation should be obtained.
- Tuesday was particularly well received; positive feedback was also received from official sources (e.g., at the Senate meeting).
- A student evaluation survey is planned for future events.
- Preliminary figures indicate a small financial surplus (final accounts are still pending).

- High personnel costs, especially in the area of food service; nevertheless, high motivation within the team.
- Consideration of using the Fass more as an event location (rather than purely for parties) in the summer.
- The StuPa also expressed positive feedback.
- Use of leftovers:
  - Remaining beverages and food were used up.
  - Leftover wine stocks from the winter semester are to be used, for example, in a raffle or as mulled wine in winter.
- During the lecture-free period, all Fass rooms are to be tidied up and organized.
- The purchase of new beer tent furniture is planned.
- New mulled wine cups are to be ordered at the end of September.
- New freezers are to be purchased for the 2026 summer semester.
- Advertising for the Fass team is to take place at the Ersti Rally.

### **Agenda Item 8 Office and Sports Department: Freshman bags/mentor program**

- Planning for the freshman bags is underway, internal coordination has been completed.
- The aim is to include less paper and more practical items (“gadgets”).
- Planned contents include: AStA condoms, cigarette papers/filters, pocket ashtrays (e.g., via Rheingau CleanUp).

### **Agenda Item 9 Media department: Housing groups / Offer**

- Conscious maintenance of the housing group (Facebook), also keeping an eye on overlaps with the classified ads group (WhatsApp)
- A newsletter is considered a useful addition.
- Increased promotion of the ID project via social media
- Discussion about purchasing an AStA cell phone (for central management of contacts, social media, SumUp access data, etc.); financing via StuPa with contract or approval, if necessary.
- Mentoring program to be promoted via social media.
- Creation of recruitment videos for open department positions (e.g., Fass, Culture).
- A uniform AStA logo/watermark should be stored in Canva to ensure recognition in publications.
- The AStA stand at the freshman rally should be designed more professionally (with roll-ups, etc.).

### **Agenda Item 10 Cultural Department: Staffing situation, rough overview, first semester rally, Open Campus 2025**

- The staffing situation is currently good; Lars may provide support for the Fass team.
- The first semester rally will take place on the first Tuesday of the winter semester. The entire AStA team is scheduled to help with setup, stations, and the party afterwards.
- The rally may start two hours earlier; early communication with the university regarding the schedule is necessary.
- Possible semester opening/closing party in cooperation with the Rhenanen
- Flunkyball tournament (with a larger scope and stronger promotion)
- Janis Becker to return as moderator of the “Kleiderkette”
- Cooperation with Weingut Woi as sponsor
- Open Campus 2025 (August 30/31):
  - The AStA will take over beverage sales

- Refrigerated truck has already been reserved Financing is covered by the university (personnel costs will be covered)
- Call for all members to help, including temporary staff if necessary (approx. 5 people needed)
