



This year, **BAföG celebrated its 50th anniversary** - unfortunately with a new minus record: Only 11% of all students still receive BAföG from the state - and not all of them the maximum rate. More and more students have to look for alternative sources of funding for their studies.

In order to simplify the research for you, there is now the "**Study Financing Check**" from Studis Online. With it, you can now quickly, easily and individually check whether, in addition to BAföG, other sources of money are possible. The "Student Financing Check" is free of charge and independent!
