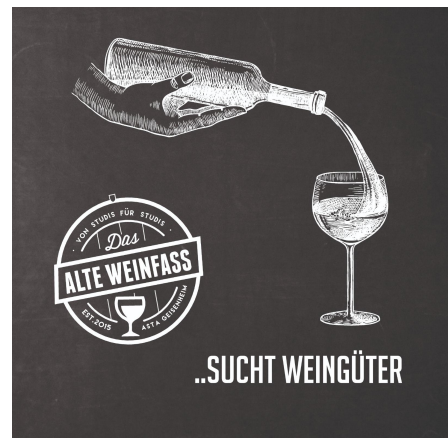

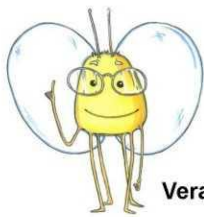

A learning technique right for the exam preparation:

Trees are more than just important factors in climate protection. Their fascinating structures can inspire us to organize information and maximize the learning outcome.

Mind mapping is a creative visualization technique that takes advantage of this concept and organizes, structures, and visualizes ideas and information. But that's not all – mind maps are effective tools to learn complex concepts in a "brain-friendly" manner so that information can be recalled for a long time, which makes them **perfect for exam preparation!**

Employees of Geisenheim University pay instead of the registration fee of 59€ only 39€ & students even only 29€!

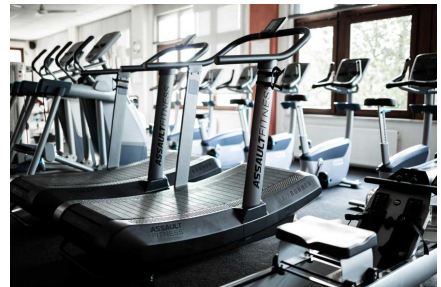

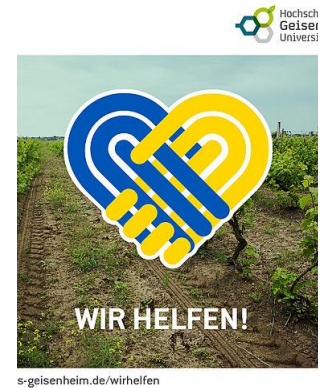

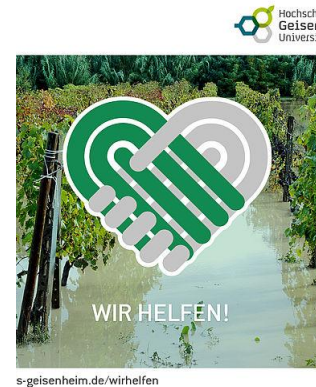
... in Ukraine

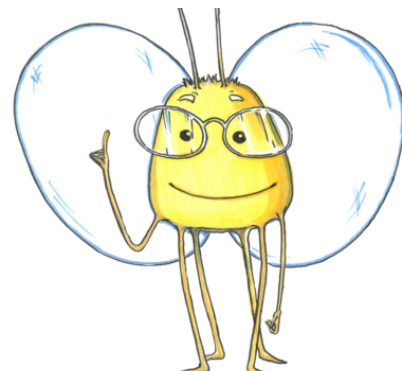

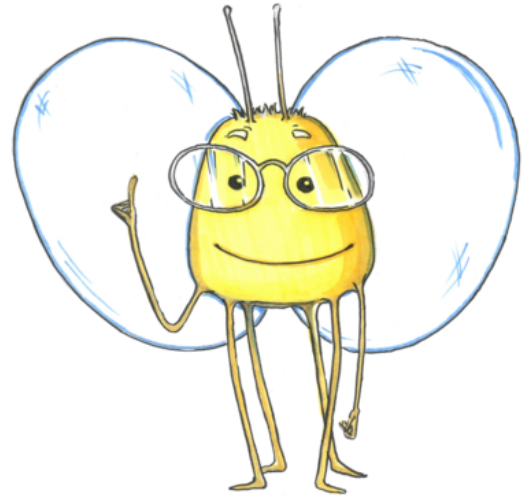

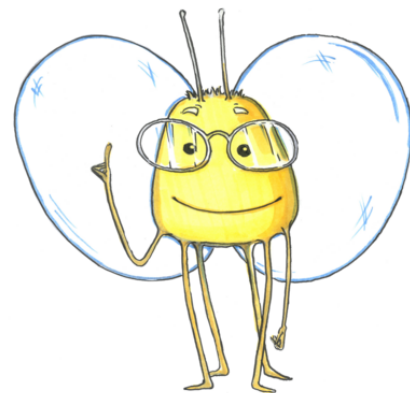
