Funding

This year, **BAföG celebrated its 50th anniversary** - unfortunately with a new minus record: Only 11% of all students still receive BAföG from the state - and not all of them the maximum rate. More and more students have to look for alternative sources of funding for their studies.

In order to simplify the research for prospective students, students, their parents and advisors, there is now the "**Study Financing Check**" from Studis Online. With it, everyone can now quickly, easily and individually check whether, in addition to BAföG, other sources of money such as child support, alimony, housing allowance, unemployment benefits, scholarships, education loans, KfW student loans or other loans and funds are possible. In addition to the question of possible assets, it takes into account many individual factors of the person in question or the studies.

And the best thing is: The "Student Financing Check" is free of charge and independent.

Benefit from discounted family time off

Eligible families pay only about ten percent of the usual cost for room and board. The stay may last up to one week (maximum of seven nights). Families can claim the subsidy twice: once for a stay in 2021 and once for a stay in 2022. The Federal Ministry of Family Affairs will provide a total of up to 50 million euros for the measure in 2021 and 2022.

The common path to more sustainability: **Lecture event** with discussion

Sustainability is one of the most frequently invoked principles in our society; we get confronted with promises of sustainability, when we go shopping for the week just as we do when we choose our energy supplier. But what really matters when it comes to sustainable consumption? And what steps does an institution like Geisenheim University have to take on the way to climate neutrality as an aspect of sustainability?

As an impulse, Dr. Immanuel Stieß, head of research on energy and climate protection in everyday life at the Institute for Social-Ecological Research (ISOE), will give the lecture "Sustainable consumption in everyday life - what does it depend on?". He will show how each and every individual can consume more sustainably in everyday life. The focus will be on the areas of nutrition and mobility.

Georg Ardissone-Krauss, M.Sc., a doctoral student at the Institute for Applied Ecology at Geisenheim University of Applied Sciences, will present the university's path to improving its own carbon footprint in his lecture "Energetic CO2 balance of Geisenheim University - What does it look like, the path to climate neutrality?" and report on the measures the institution is taking today and in the future.
