

Third examination attempt – request for oral exam

Extract from the “General Provisions for Assessment Regulations” (ABPO) for all degree programs at Hochschule Geisenheim University

3.9 (5) Resitting examinations, failure at final attempt

For examinations, which may only be taken in the form of a written examination, the Special Provisions may allow the final attempt to be taken in the form of an oral examination.

How to apply for an oral exam:

- Please check the conditions for your final examination attempt in the Special Provisions for Assessment Regulations (BBPO) of your degree program:

→ select your program
- The request for your third attempt to be taken as an oral exam must be submitted in writing to the Chairperson of the Examination Committee. No specific form is required.
- Please make sure to inform your module coordinator of your request for an oral examination.
- The Chairperson of the Examination Committee sets the exam date and appoints the Examination Board, which consists of three examiners.
